All her designs are more traditional and look more complicated than actual when broken down. This is a good book for beginners to machine quilting because it goes into detail of all types of stitching needed to complete a quilt. I would encourage anyone who machine quilts no matter what type of machine you are using; to get this book. It is a great go-to book when you don't know what to use to fill the space of a quilt
