In this book she used yard goods for the background fabric and fat quarters for the rest of the quilt fabric. The projects in this book have a very scrappy look, very easy piecing techniques, and timeless in their look. So, if you are tempted to stock up on fat quarters, stop by and get this book to help you put them together, with clear charts of fabric needs along with different quilt size details in the same simple chart. In the basic instructions, there is a connect the binding technique, that I have used for years, which is illustrated and written in very good detail. Try this technique! I really think this book is a good one for those who like lots of fabric in one quilt and who love to buy all the fat quarters they can find, easy for beginners. Add this one to your bookshelf.
