## Thank you, Janda! It's not too late!

It is time to say a big “thanks” to our outstanding President, Janda! She has had extra duty this year with the change in meeting place and all the challenges that brought, and the summer quilt art event, plus she planned a fun sew day in August. What a great job, she truly went over and beyond!

Traditionally, to thank the outgoing President, everyone makes a block for her. Janda has chosen a basket block like the ones in the picture. She would like the blocks made for her to be in brights and the handles embroidered, appliquéd, or made of rick rack! It really is a fun block, I think I'll make some for myself!

### Directions:

For a 6” basket block

- Cut for largest triangle for top background: cut a 5 and 3/8 inch square, sub cut diagonally in half
- Cut for bottom corner background: cut a 3 and 7/8 inch square sub cut diagonally in half
- Cut for background sides: cut 2 inch by 3 and a half inch rectangles, cut 2
- Cut for basket base from basket color: cut a 2 and 3/8 inch square sub cut diagonally in half
- Cut for basket base from basket color: cut a 5 and 3/8 inch square, sub cut diagonally in half

### Tips:

- I used a 4 inch circle as a handle template and made it a half inch wide
- I fused my appliqué handle before sewing the block together

Bring your finished gift block to the January and February meetings to present to Janda in March! It will be so fun to see what everyone made!
