A new advertising Policy was reviewed and approved by the Executive Board at their May 20, 2013 meeting. The Policy states:

### **Advertisement and Advertisers Silver Needles Quilt Guild Monthly Newsletter**

The Silver Needles Quilt Guild has approved the following Advertisement and Advertisers Policy for the monthly Newsletter.

Advertisements and Advertisers will be approved by the Silver Needles Quilt Guild Board.

It is the intention of this policy to be an avenue to enrich the community through quilting, to stimulate an interest in quilts, to promote and advance the art of quilt making. It is also to encourage the preservation of quilts and their history.

Advertisements and Advertisers can sell quilting related items including but not limited to: sewing machines, fabric, and services available to quilters or products of interest to quilt makers. This can include quilt shops, fabric stores, machine or hand-quilters, etc.

Advertisements and Advertisers will pay an annual (12 months) fee of \$60.00 for the right to have a display ad the size of a business card in each printed or electronically distributed Silver Needles Quilt Guild Newsletter. The year is from February through January.

Advertisements and Advertisers who express interest in an advertisement space, with less than one year remaining will be given the following pro-rated fee:

- March – May - \$40.00
- June – August - \$20.00
- September – November - \$10.00

The Silver Needles Quilters Guild reserves the right to refuse advertisement space to objectionable content.
