Our June program will be presented by Kaye Spitzle, Christina DeArmand, and Eula Lang from Quilting Bits & Pieces. They say that every quilt shop has a personality, and Quilting Bits and Pieces is no different! These ladies have been in business for over 20 years and feature extraordinary decorative hand work and embroidery stitching. The program presented will be titled "Heirloom Stitches" which will include a trunk show!

EXTRA, EXTRA WORKSHOP

In addition to the evening program Kaye Spitzle, Christina DeArmand, and Eula Lang will be presenting a workshop to teach a handwork stitch call "twilling" in the afternoon of June 17, 2019 from 2:00 - 4:00 pm. The twilling stitch technique, also called Palestrina, has its origin in Italy. Generally, it is used for bordering or outlining. The stitch has variations, often worked with pearl cotton, and can be used on a variety of fabrics. The "knotted line" effect is a striking addition to hand work pieces.

Registration information for Twilling Workshop

Participants will receive a practice piece with everything needed to learn this decorative stitch. The workshop must have 6 participants and is limited to 15. The fee is \$30.00 and includes everything needed to learn this ancient stitch technique.
