### Quilting Tip of the month

Parchment paper, yes the rolls you buy at the grocery store to bake cookies on and save clean up time, is also a great quilting tool. I use it as a press cloth when working with fusible, it keeps my ironing board free from the glue when I use it on the iron board and more importantly when used between the iron and fabric being fused it keeps the fusible from sticking to my iron. Saves on cleaning up time and keeps everything free from the mess of glue and an added advantage, I reuse the same piece over and over again until it gets torn or scorched, so it is very inexpensive too. Saves time, is easy to use and inexpensive, now what could be better than that...well besides a nice big piece of chocolate cake and a whole afternoon to quilt!
